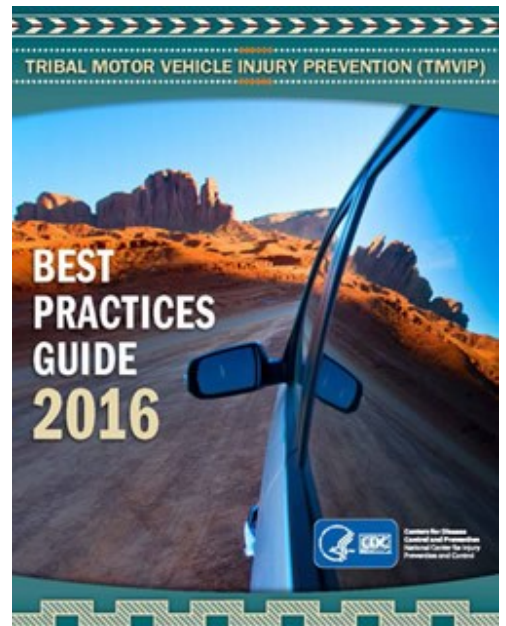

On March 22-24, NIJC will conduct a training session on **Public Health and Transportation in Indian Country** at the Atlantis Hotel and Casino in Reno, Nevada. This training session will focus on identifying motor-vehicle related injuries as a public health problem in Native American communities. This session will also highlight the “*Tribal Motor Vehicle Injury Prevention Best Practices Guide 2016*” developed exclusively for Native American communities by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. Participants will receive a training manual and a certificate of achievement upon completion of the training session.

The National Indian Justice Center, Inc., (NIJC) is an Indian owned and operated non-profit corporation with principal offices in Santa Rosa, California. NIJC was established in 1983 to serve as an independent national resource for Native communities and tribal governments.
