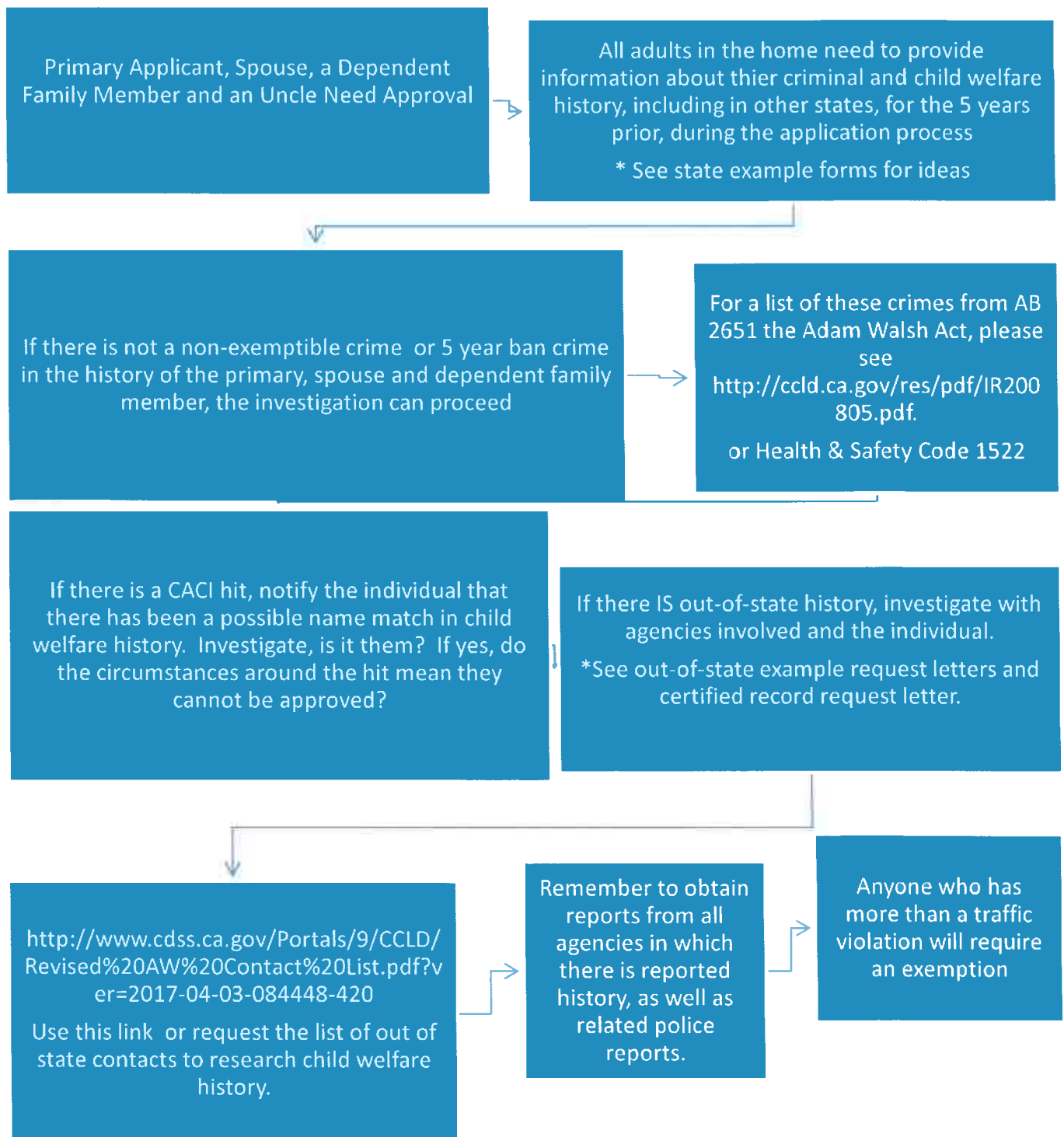

## Tribal Agency Go-To-Guide

Each person who needs an exemption is notified of the investigation, and asked for information to prove their good character

See example letters for lists and suggested verbiage for all of these processes

**Confirm that it's not a non-exemptible or 5-year ban crime**

There are different types of exemptions: **Standard, Conditional, and Simple**. Please see specific criterion for each. Tribal Agencies get to customize the type they offer, according to their needs and culture

\* What is the criterion? See DRAFT ACL or obtain list from the state

*The court and county are more likely to be in agreement with an exemption, if collobarated with along the way*

*MOUs in advance or even better*

If anyone is denied placement or exemption due to criminal history, they are entitled of a copy of their CORI

After an individual is approved - either initial background check cleared, or through exemption, the Tribal Agency will get updates as to criminal and child welfare history. These typically must be investigated and approved

**MUST** notify the county worker and/or supervisor within 24 hours of receipt of this info. Recommend Tribal Agency has a back up plan fro the child in advance, if possible

If it is a violent crime, a non exemptible or 5 year ban crime, or a crime that would put children's health & safety at risk, the individual must move, or the tribal child must move.
